
Highway 427 Expansion TRAFFIC UPDATES



Bulletin #13: Temporary Road Closure at McGillivray Road

Please be advised that starting on **June 13, 2019** the northern section of McGillivray Road at Huntington Road will be temporarily closed until **September 30, 2019** to facilitate construction activities of the Highway 427 Expansion Project. There will temporarily be no access to McGillivray Road from Huntington Road as bridge construction is being completed for the future crossing of Highway 427 over CP Rail and McGillivray Road. These works include the completion of bridge piers and bridge abutments. Access to McGillivray Road from Rutherford Road will remain open at this time.



We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this period of construction. Please reduce your speed through construction zones for the safety of all road users and our workers.
