Huntington Road Closure



Huntington Road South of Major Mackenzie Drive Closure: October 28, 2019

On October 28, 2019, LINK427 will permanently close to the travelling public (e.g. vehicles, cyclists, pedestrians, etc.) the portion of Huntington Road from McGillivray Road to Major Mackenzie Drive West. Huntington Road is being permanently closed so that the new Highway 427 interchange at Major Mackenzie Drive can be built.

Signs informing of the upcoming closure have been posted on Huntington Road near the closure area.

Authority for the permanent closing of various roads (including Huntington Road) at the points where they intersect with the Highway 427 extension from Highway 7 to Major Mackenzie Drive was granted by the Ontario Municipal Board (Case #: MM160043) on October 7, 2016.

What is the Highway 427 Expansion Project?

The Highway 427 Expansion project will extend the highway 6.6 km, from Highway 7 to Major Mackenzie Drive and widen the existing highway to 8 lanes between Finch Avenue and Highway 7.

Who is LINK427?

LINK427 is the consortium selected by the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) and Infrastructure Ontario (IO) to design, build, finance, and maintain the Highway 427 widening and extension.
